ORDER

As per G.O. read (1) above the Excise Commissioner has to approve the upset value fixed by the Mechanical Engineer (Excise) in respect of all vehicles seized after 01.01.2005 before the vehicles are placed for public auction.

- 2. In the G.O (2) cited, Government have ordered that the fair value of seized vehicles may be fixed by the Mechanical Engineer in Excise Department, but the power to auction will be with the Deputy Excise Commissioner and Joint Excise Commissioner.
- 3. In this regard Excise Commissioner has requested to delegate the power to approve the upset value of the vehicles fixed by the Mechanical Engineer (Excise) to Deputy Excise Commissioner/ Joint Excise Commissioner (zonal) for speedy disposal of vehicles.
- 4. Government having examined the matter in detail, are pleased to delegate the power to approve the upset value of confiscated /seized vehicles in Excise Department fixed by Mechanical Engineer (Excise) to the Deputy / Joint Excise Commissioner (zonal).
