In exercise of the powers conferred under section 24 of the Abkari Act (1 of 1077), and in supersession of the notification issued under G.O.(P) No. 145/2018/TD dated 12th September 2018 and published as S.R.O. No. 629/2018 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 2308 dated 12th September, 2018, the Government of Kerala hereby direct that the fee shown in column 5 of the table shown below shall be levied on each permit and No Objection Certificate (NOC) issued under said Act for the quantity shown in column No. 4 to all licensees under the Foreign Liquor Rules, 1953, the Brewery Rules, 1967, the Kerala Distillery and Warehouse Rules, 1968, the Kerala Winery Rules, 1970, the Kerala Rectified Spirit Rules, 1972 and the



Kerala Foreign Liquor (Compounding, Blending and Bottling) Rules, 1975 for the purpose of importing, exporting or transporting any kind of liquor and rectified spirit including absolute alcohol.

Explanation: For the purpose of this notification, case means 48 bottles of 180ml each or 24 bottles of 375 ml each or 18 bottles of 500 ml each or 12 bottles of 750 ml each or 9 bottles of 1000 ml each of Foreign Liquor or 24 bottles of 330 ml each or 24 cans of 500 ml each or 12 bottles of 650 ml each of beer.

This notification shall come into force at once.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per the existing notification and circulars, No Objection Certificate (NOC) and permits are issued for a particular quantity of liquor fixed by the Government or Excise Commissioner as the case may be. Issue of more than one Non Objection Certificate or permit to a single consignment causes processing hurdles to the licensees. In order to avoid the above hurdles and to protect Government revenue, Government have decided to fix the fee on the Non Objection Certificate and permits issued under sections 6, 7 and 11 of Abkari Act, (1 of 1077) on the basis of the quantity covered under each permit. For this purpose it has been decided to issue notification fixing the rate of Non Objection Certificate and permits and quantity of liquor covered in each permit in supersession of the notification issued under G.O. (P) No. 145/2018/TD dated 12th September, 2018.

This notification is intended to achieve the above object.
