## ORDER

As per the Government Orders read as Ist,2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> papers above, the entire expenses for the treatment of Police, Fire force, Forest personnels injured in the accidents while performing official duties including treatment availed from Private/Specialized hospitals will be reimbursed in relaxation of Rule 6 and 8 of the Kerala Government servants Medical Attendance Rules, 1960. The Commissioner of Excise, Thiruvananthapuram in his letter read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above has requested to extend the same facilities to Excise personnel injured in the official duties.

(2) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that the entire expenses for treatment of Excise personnels injured in the official duties including treatment availed from Private/Specialized hospitals shall be reimbursed in relaxation of Rule 6 and 8 of the KGSMA Rules, 1960. The admissibility of the claim will be verified by the District Medical Officer/ Director of Health Services as per the financial powers delegated from time to time.
