S. R. O. No. 658/2017—In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 18A and 29 of the Abkari Act, 1 of 1077, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Abkari Shops Disposal Rules, 2002 issued by notification under G. O. (P) No. 24/2002/TD dated 30th March, 2002 and published as S.R.O. No. 198/2002 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 376 dated 30th March, 2002, namely:—

RULES

- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Abkari Shops Disposal (Amendment) Rule, 2017.
 - (2) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. Amendment of the rules.—In the Kerala Abkari Shops Disposal Rules, 2002, in sub-rule (37) of rule 7, the words, symbol and figure "or Foreign Liquor-1" shall be omitted.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the Notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per sub-rule (37) of rule 7 of the Kerala Abkari Shops Disposal Rules, 2002, no woman shall be employed in any capacity in a Toddy or Foreign Liquor-1 shop. Now the Government have decided to employ women in Foreign Liquor-1 shop. In order to implement the above said decision the Government have decided to amend the said rule suitably.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
