S. R. O. No. 798/2014.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 18A, 24 and 29 of the Abkari Act I of 1077, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Foreign Liquor Rules issued under Notification No. SR 4-1859/52/RD dated 17th January, 1953 and published in the Travancore-Cochin Gazette Extraordinary No. 2 dated 17th January, 1953, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Foreign Liquor (6th Amendment) Rules, 2014.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of the Rules.*—In the Foreign Liquor Rules,—

(1) in rule 28, for sub-rule (1), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

“(1) No. FL-3 Hotels (Restaurants) shall be kept open before 9.30 in the morning and after 10 O’ clock in the night. No. FL-1 shop shall be kept open before 9 O’ clock in the morning and after 11 O’ clock in the night.”

(2) in rule 28A, item (x) shall be omitted.

(3) in FORM FL. 1, under the heading “CONDITIONS”, in condition No. 16, item (x) shall be omitted.

(4) in FORM FL. 3, under the heading “CONDITIONS”,—

(a) for condition No. 20, the following condition shall be substituted, namely:—

“20. No. FL-3 Hotels (Restaurants) shall be kept open before 9.30 in the morning and after 10 O’ clock in the night”.

(b) in condition No. 20A, item (x) shall be omitted.

(5) in FORM FL. 4, under the heading “CONDITTONS”, in condition No. 2A, item (x) shall be omitted.

(6) in FORM FL. 4A, under the heading “CONDITIONS”, in condition No. 18, item (x) shall be omitted.

(7) in FORM FL. 11, under the heading “CONDITIONS”, in condition No. 9, item (x) shall be omitted.

(8) in FORM FL. 12, under the heading “CONDITIONS”, in condition No. 9, item (x) shall be omitted.

(9) in FORM FL. 13, under the heading “CONDITIONS”, in condition No. 8, item (x) shall be omitted.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Government vide G. O. (Ms.) No. 205/2014/TD, dated 20th December, 2014, have decided to exclude Sundays from the list of Dry days. It is also decided to fix the working hours of FL Shops from 9.30 in the morning to 10.00 in the night. In order to give statutory validity to the above decisions Foreign Liquor Rules needs to be amended.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
