S. R. O. No. 192/2015.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 18A of the Abkari Act, 1 of 1077, read with sub-rule (2) of rule 3, and sub-rules (4) and (5) of rule 4 of the Kerala Abkari Shops Disposal Rules, 2002, the Government of Kerala hereby extend the period of privilege of vending, selling or supply granted in respect of the Foreign Liquor-1 shops specified in column (3) of the schedule to the notification issued under G. O. (P) No. 66/2008/TD, dated 27th March, 2008 and published as S.R.O. No. 322/2008 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 617 dated 27th March, 2008, and consequently make the following amendment to the said notification, namely:—

33/1273/2015/S-7.

AMENDMENT

1. In the said notification, in the second paragraph, for the word, figures, symbols and letters "1st April 2014", the word, figures, symbols and letters "1st April 2015" shall be substituted.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per the notification issued under G. O. (P) No. 66/2008/TD, dated 27th March, 2008 and published as S. R. O. No. 322/2008 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 617 dated 27th March, 2008, Government have notified the details of the FL-1 shops with scheduled limits. In the said notification, the period of privilege of vending, selling or supply granted was only up to 31st March, 2015. The Government have decided to extend the period of privilege granted in respect of FL-1 shops for a further period of one year, with effect from 1st April, 2015, for which the said notification has to be amended.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
