S. R. O. No. 381/2012.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 17, 18, 24 and 29 of the Abkari Act 1 of 1077, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Distillery and Warehouse Rules, 1968, namely:—

RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Distillery and Warehouse (Amendment) Rules, 2012.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of the Rules.*—In the Kerala Distillery and Warehouse Rules, 1968, in FORM IV A, under the heading, “CONDITIONS”,—

(a) in condition number 5, the words “based on the report of the Chief Chemical Examiner to Government certifying that the Extra Neutral Alcohol/Grape Spirit is fit for reprocessing” shall be added at the end;

(b) in condition number 18, for the first sentence, the following sentence shall be substituted, namely:—

“The licensee shall pay in the Government treasury in advance in the first day of each month, from the date of obtaining the licence, the average cost of the staff appointed for the purpose of excise supervision which includes dearness allowance, uniform allowance and other compensatory allowances and also pension and leave salary contributions calculated at such rates as may be prescribed by the Excise Commissioner from time to time.”;

(c) in condition number 22, for the words “the license shall not dispose”, the words “the licensee shall not dispose” shall be substituted.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Committee on Subordinate Legislation (2006-2008) in its fifth report presented to the House on 14th March, 2008 after scrutinising the S. R. Os. issued by the Government under the provisions of the Abkari Act 1 of 1077 during the years 2004 and 2005 have made certain observations, comments and recommendations in respect of certain S. R. Os. The Committee has recommended certain modifications, in G. O. (P) No. 7/2005/TD dated 24th January, 2005 published as S. R. O. No. 66/2005 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 149 dated 24th January, 2005, which was issued to amend the Kerala Distillery and Warehouse Rules, 1968 for giving much clarity to the provisions in the said Rules. The Government have decided to implement the recommendations of the Committee by amending the said Rules.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
