### Abstract

Taxes Department - Excise Establishment - Scheme for increasing the promotional avenues of Civil Excise Officers and Preventive Officers - Modified orders issued.

### ORDER

As per the Government Order read above, a scheme for increasing the promotional avenues of Excise Guards and Preventive Officers, in line with that implemented in Police Department, has been introduced. As part of this scheme, Government ordered to designate the Excise Guards who have completed 15 years of service in the cadre in the Division concerned, as Preventive Officer (Grade), and promotee Preventive Officers who have completed 23 years of total service in the posts of Excise Guard and Preventive Officer are designated as Assistant Excise Inspector (Grade) subject to the specific condition that a junior shall not supersede a qualified senior in such grade promotion only on the basis of length of service.

2) The Commissioner of Excise - vide his letter read above has informed Government that for achieving the actual objective of the above mentioned Government Order to the Excise personnel in the cadre of Civil Excise Officer (Excise Guard), and to avoid junior - senior anomalies in the Department, it is necessary to delete the conditions incorporated as clause (A) I (i), (A) III (iv), (B) III (iv) and the condition in clause (B) I (i) of the Government Order referred above that "subject to the specific condition that a junior shall not supersede a qualified senior in such grade promotion only".

3) Government have examined all aspects of the issue in detail, and are pleased to order the following modifications in the Government Order read above, in order to enhance the promotional avenues of Civil Excise Officers and Preventive Officers.

- (i) To delete the condition (A) I (i) whereby the Civil Excise Officer who is appointed district-wise have to complete 15 years in the Division concerned, to get Preventive Officer Grade.

(ii) To delete the conditions (A) III (iv), (B) I (i) and (B) III (iv), in order to avoid the junior - senior anomaly that may happen while granting grade promotion as per the Government Order read above.

4) The Government Order read above stands modified to the above extent only.
