In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 24 and 29 of the Abkari Act 1 of 1077, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Foreign Liquor Rules issued under notification No. SR4-1859/52/RD dated 17th January, 1953 and published in the Travancore-Cochin Gazette Extraordinary No. 2 dated 17th January, 1953, namely:—



RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Foreign Liquor (3rd Amendment) Rules, 2020.

(2) They shall be deemed to be come into force with effect from the 23rd day of March, 2020.

2. *Amendment of the Rules.*— In the Foreign Liquor Rules, after Rule 14A, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:—

“14B. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, if any circumstance warrants, the Government may, by order, extend the period of any licence granted under these rules, for such period.”

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

At present, there is no provision in the Foreign Liquor Rules for the extension of the period of existing licences when an emergency situation arise. In order to overcome such situation, Foreign Liquor Rules need to be amended. Hence, the Government have decided to amend the said rules suitably.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
