ORDER

Due to the outbreak of Covid-19, Government as per the G.O. read as 1st paper above, have extended the time upto 31-07-2020 for the renewal of licenses, registration of brands, permits, approval of labels etc. under the Abkari Act and Rules. Now the Excise Commissioner in the letter read as 2nd paper above has reported that the situation of Covid-19 pandemic has not eased yet and the nation wide lock-down has led to the disruption of industrial and commercial activities and it made difficult to complete the entire label registration process and brand registration process within the allotted time period. As such he has requested that considering the above situation extend the time limit for the brand registration and label approval upto 30-09-2020.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to grant further extension of time upto 30-09-2020 for the brand registration and label approval, under the Abkari Act and Rules, in the light of the lock-down due to the outbreak of Covid-19.

Excise Commissioner shall take necessary action in this regard.
