In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 18 A and 29 of the Abkari Act, I of 1077, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Abkari Shops Disposal Rules, 2002 issued by notification under G. O. (P) No. 24/2002/TD. dated 30th March, 2002 and published as S.R.O. No. 198/2002 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 376 dated 30th March, 2002, namely:—



RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Kerala Abkari Shops Disposal (4th Amendment) Rules, 2023.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of the rules.*— In the Kerala Abkari Shops Disposal Rules, 2002,—

in rule 5,—

in clause (a) of sub rule (1)—

(a) in the first sentence for the figures and symbol “ 2019-20”, the figures, symbol and words “2022-23 and the extended period” shall be substituted.

(b) for the second sentence, the following sentence shall be substituted, namely:—

“The licensees who have conducted the shops during the years from 2020-21 to 2022-23 and the extended period, whose licenses cancelled due to registration of Abkari cases and subsequently exonerated by the Court shall also be given preference”.
